Turner Department of Construction Management at Louisiana State University (LSU), Assistant Director for LSU-Industrial Assessment Center funded by the US Department of Energy (USDOE), Program Coordinator for Region 6 University Transportation Center funded by the US Department of Transportation (USDOT). His main research areas lie in Construction Safety and Health, Data Sensing and Analytics, Exoskeleton or Exosuit.
